Lutheran Child and Family Services (LCFS) was started by two Lutheran churches in the Indianapolis area 132 years ago as an orphanage. The LCFS of today provides much needed care for individuals and children in Indiana.

Some of our programs include –

Lutherwood Residential Treatment Facility for boys and girls age 6-21 who exhibit chronic behavior and/or emotional problems.

Emergency Shelter Care -boys and girls up to 18 years of age who need emergency shelter from abusive situations.

The Sharing Place – a material assistance program that provides free food and/or clothing to individuals on the east side of Indianapolis.

IMPACT – a residential program dedicated to treating juvenile girls at risk of becoming or are victims of human trafficking.

Trinity House –a group home for young men age 14-21 that are taught life skills as they transition from foster care.

S.E.E.D. –A faith based program offered to residents that includes voluntary weekly chapel service and bible study.
