Plato Learning Online:

Including online courses and credit recovery, through which students can earn high school credits at their own pace, in a classroom setting

Scholastic Read 180:

A reading intervention program: including computer-based learning, independent reading, small group, and whole group instruction methods.

Title 1 Tutoring:

After school tutoring program for students who are behind grade level in reading or math, or seeking homework help

Contemporary GED Online:

A self-paced, computer and textbook based, program for students preparing for the GED

School enrollment on campus fosters close involvement between school personnel and clinical professionals, allowing the treatment team to gain a broader perspective, and create further personalized plans of care. Open communication between parents, guardians, and the education team is encouraged.

Lutherwood Academy strives to allow differentiated instruction to occur in a safe setting, while preparing students to successfully return to typical schools upon discharge from the residential program.
