# The Sharing Place Sees Increase in Clients in 2023

As you might have noticed, inflation has been causing many hardships for everyone recently.

The impact of inflation is something we have witnessed at The Sharing Place. As of April, The Sharing Place has served 16,585 clients in 2023. This is over 3,000 more than last April at 12,957.

The increase in clients being served also brings an increase in volunteers needed at The Sharing Place. Volunteers are the heart of the program, without volunteers our day-to-day operations would not be possible.

This Summer, the building is expecting some construction which will hinder the ability for our staff to use pallet jacks to assist with bringing in deliveries. The construction is set to begin June 6th and last until the end of July. Because of this construction, we are seeking additional volunteers on Wednesday afternoons and Friday mornings.

We were blessed to be able to host another Top Golf fundraiser for the second year in a row! Between the warm weather and good conversation, the day couldn't have been more perfect.


